

Minute for Mission: Disciples Women



Disciples Women partners with Global Ministries each year to lead a delegation of women to a different country, to make connections with our sisters and to better understand what it means to be a woman of faith in that country. These two ministries work together to focus on countries with concerns and efforts that relate to the work of Disciples Women. During Global Ministry initiatives, a country within that initiative is chosen as a destination so the members of that delegation may also be spokespeople for the issues addressed in that initiative.



For example, in 2017, the delegation visited with partners in India to discover the work being done there to combat human trafficking and to focus on the rescue of victims, as well as training and care to improve their potential for healthy futures. In Durgapur, children who have been rescued, and those who are being protected from trafficking, attend a school that not only provides basic education, but also includes job training, music and dance training, and sewing. The women received an extravagant welcome from the churches near Malda and the children of the Safe House there, which provides care, shelter, and training for children, protecting them from traffickers.

The women learned about the vast programs caring for children, women, and men through advocacy, action, training, and immediate care.
